Prof Anne Abbott is a neurologist who has spent most of her time over the last 15 years researching how to better prevent stroke, particularly stroke associated with carotid arterial disease. Her work is having a significant impact in updating international stroke guidelines, policy and practice for improved patient outcomes. She completed neurology training at The Queen Elizabeth Hospital (Adelaide), a PhD at the National Stroke Research Institute (Melbourne) and a post doc at the Baker IDI Heart and Diabetes Institute (Melbourne). She is currently based at the School of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Monash University (Melbourne) where she would like to establish a study of the efficacy of current optimal diagnosis and management of heart/vascular disease risk factors in preventing stroke and other complications.
